How do I Reset my Calculator?

Slot the new battery into the compartment. Ensure that the positive side (with writing) faces up... And the negative side faces the calculator's screen. Slot the battery cover back on and screw it down. If you need to reset the calculator after this, it's SHIFT+9 &gt; 3 &gt; =. Otherwise, you're ready to crunch numbers again!
