Does New Zealand have solar subsidies?

New Zealand has had no solar subsidies in comparison with the United States, the United Kingdom, and Australia, which have all implemented various financial incentives to support the adoption of solar energy. Larsson highlighted that more than 30,000 individuals have signed a Greenpeace petition urging the government to invest in household solar.
