Does New Zealand have a solar hot water subsidy program?

From 2007 to 2012, though, the government launched a \$500 subsidy for solar hot water system suppliers who comply with specific performance, price, and installation standards.

While we don't currently have nationwide subsidies for home solar systems, there are still several practical incentives and support options available for Kiwis keen to harness the sun's power. The biggest incentive in 2025 comes from electricity retailers offering competitive rates for excess solar energy you send back to the grid.

Is solar energy safe in New Zealand?

Solar energy use and conversion don't result in carbon emissions and are, therefore, environmentally safe.
