How much does a solar plant cost in Vietnam?

Vietnam's Ministry of Industry and Trade (MoIT) has published the new feed-in tariffs for utility-scale solar plants. For projects without battery storage, the tariff will be VND 1,382.7 (\$0.053)/kWhfor the northern part of the country, VDN 1,107.1/kWh for the central part, and VDN 1,012.0/kWh for the southern region.

Does Vietnam need a 2025 Solar Plan?

Notably, the 2025 plan mandates that concentrated solar must include storage (minimum 10 percent of capacity, 2-hour duration), a requirement absent in the 2023 version. Vietnam's solar panel trade is regulated under Decree 26/2023/ND-CP, which outlines the Schedule of Export Tariffs and Preferential Import Tariffs.

How much solar power does Vietnam have?

This included 16 billion kWhfrom solar power and 7.3 billion kWh from wind energy, according to data from Vietnam Electricity. Solar power, in particular, has seen significant expansion due to the implementation of feed-in tariffs and the increasing adoption of rooftop solar systems.

How is solar energy regulated in Vietnam?

Vietnam's solar power sector is governed by a number of key regulations and policiesaimed at promoting the development of renewable energy while managing the challenges associated with rapid growth.

How has the FIT program impacted solar power development in Vietnam?

The FiT program has been a major driver of solar power development in Vietnam, offering a tariff of 9.35 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) for projects completed by June 2019. This program led to a surge in solar capacity, reaching 4.46 gigawatts of new installations.
